Report Six – United Auto Workers

**Following is the third report on seven leading industrial unions with membership who strongly support the Trump-Vance agenda, but whose leadership have abandoned the will of their membership and taken on a heavily liberal partisan lean. This report focuses on the United Auto Workers union.**

When President Trump secured the Republican nomination in 2016 and then subsequently defeated Hillary Clinton, he completed a fundamental re-alignment of the Republican Party's policy agenda and its electoral base. The President's re-alignment endured through the Biden election in 2021 and through the President's re-election in 2025. A crucial part of the President's re-alignment of the Republican Party was his focus on issues that were vital to blue-collar workers, particularly immigration enforcement and adjustment of the U.S. trade regime through preference for bilateral agreements and the willingness to use tariffs as a tool of trade and domestic policy. At the center of the President's base was the working-class men without college degrees, many of whom were members of industrial unions.

While the broad support for the Trump-Vance agenda by industrial union members has been widely reported on, news of this nearly decade old re-alignment has apparently yet to reach the leadership of the United Auto Workers union whose dues-paying members repeatedly cast ballots for President Trump.

United Auto Workers (UAW) is the largest and most influential union in North America, led by President Shawn Fain. UAW has positioned itself as a major opponent to the Trump-Vance agenda and the Republican party, consistently opposing them in elections, on legislation, and encouraging their supporters to vote against them. UAW constantly donates to, endorses, and collaborates with Democratic politicians. Their endorsements include but are not limited to: Kamala Harris & Tim Walz in the 2024 Presidential Election, Amy Acton for Ohio Governor, and numerous current or former affiliates of the Democratic Socialists of America.

Despite many of their members being MAGA supporters, UAW has frequently opined on issues painting themselves as anti-capitalist, pro-DEI, supporters of mass immigration and as ideologically aligned with the Pro-Palestine movement, stating that Israel is conducting a "genocidal starvation campaign" on Gaza.



UAW is not shy about encouraging its members to be anti-Trump, after a UAW worker heckled President Trump on a visit to a Detroit auto plant, calling him a “pedophile protector”, the Union stood by the worker claiming that it was his right to hurl insults at the President under the first amendment.

The Union's President, Shawn Fain, is an outspoken critic of capitalism, and frequently wears a shirt that says, “eat the rich” and says that billionaires “don't have the right to exist”. This is ironic given that Fain took a luxury vacation to Puerto Rico with several board members under the pretense of a week-long meeting.

Fain also quotes Malcolm X, a Black radical from the civil rights movement, who for most of his career, advocated for separation of the Black populace from White America. Malcolm was a member of the Nation of Islam until a year before his death.

UAW has contributed nearly \$100 million on political spending from 2017-2024. Around \$4 million of this was contributed directly to Democratic party organizations such as the “Democratic Governors Association” with \$2 million being sent exclusively to them alone. Meanwhile, Republicans have received nothing, not a penny directly to them.

UAW engaged in \$300 million of wasteful & frivolous spending from 2017-2024. With all of it going to political spending, legal, hotel and conference, travel, promotional items, food and beverage, and entertainment, with \$2 million alone going to theme parks.

UAW's leadership doesn't stop at wasteful spending; they have also taken this opportunity to enrich themselves. Despite auto workers earning an average of \$55,000 a year, 56% of UAW union headquarters staff makes a six-figure salary, while only 16% of UAW employees earned a salary greater than \$150,000 a year.

UAW has betrayed its members, positioned itself as the primary union antagonist to the Trump administration, wasted hundreds of millions of dollars, lined their own pockets, all while funding Democratic institutions, candidates, and organizations.

## Methodology

### Sourcing

Spending from LM-2 forms were sourced via the Office of Labor-Management Standards payee/payor search. All entities (locals, regional councils etc.) for each union were combined into one spreadsheet to detail spending from 2017 to 2024. All spending for PACs and Independent Expenditures were gathered from the Federal Election Commission.

### Political Spending

Unlike most organizations, owing to their history of corruption, many labor unions are subjected to a much more extensive public disclosure requirement regime than most not-for-profit organizations. The chief disclosure mechanism for unions is the LM-2 form that is required by the Office of Labor-Management Standards. This form requires detailed reporting of line-item expenditures from the union, detailing nearly all expenditures by the union. In the reporting below we will detail political expenditures from the union both as detailed in their LM-2, and as detailed with the Federal Elections Commission for hard dollar political donations from their PACs and Independent Expenditures. We also detail political expenditure from the union's LM-2 that are political/advocacy in nature, including advocacy and political activities that are not necessarily tied to a registered political committee, but are clearly designed to influence public debate.

### Wasteful Spending

We have compiled the LM-2 forms for all seven unions from 2017-2024 (last available year for all unions). 2017 was used as it marked the beginning of President Trump's first term. The disclosure of union spending on these forms is broken down under five categories that include general overhead, union administration, representative activities, contributions/gifts/grants, and political activity. These spending categories (golf outing as general overhead) are often misleading, so we have created seven new classifications that more accurately describe union spending. New categories for spending are listed as follows, entertainment, food and beverage, hotel and conference, legal, political spending, swag, and travel.

#### *Categories*

**Entertainment** – Parties, amusement parks, recreational events/activities, as well as sports ventures and venues

**Food and Beverage** – Restaurants, drinks, fast food, and catering

**Hotel and Conference** – Resorts, hotels, conferences, banquets, and event venues



**Legal** – lawyers, law firms, arbitration, and any legal expenses

**Political Spending** – Advocacy, ideological organizations, candidates, committees and all expenses the union labels as political activity

**Swag** – Watches, jewelry, t-shirts, gifts, printing, and any merchandise purchased by the union

**Travel** – Airlines, travel expenses, and travel agents



## Political Spending Undermining MAGA Policies

Through its use of PAC money and union funds, the UAW has demonstrated a heavy bias towards Democrats than Republicans. The UAW has even endorsed radical socialist candidates like Zohran Mamdani.

### Nearly \$100,000,000 in Political Spending

From 2017 to 2024, the UAW has spent nearly \$100,000,000 in union funds on politics.<sup>1</sup> While much of this spending has gone to UAW National V-CAP and political advocacy groups like Superior Blue Strategies the UAW has also contributed significantly to left-wing groups like the Economic Policy Institute.

### Biased Spending Towards Democrats

Since President Trump's first term, the UAW has contributed nearly \$4,000,000 to groups directly aligned with the Democratic Party and given nothing to Republican aligned organizations.<sup>2</sup>

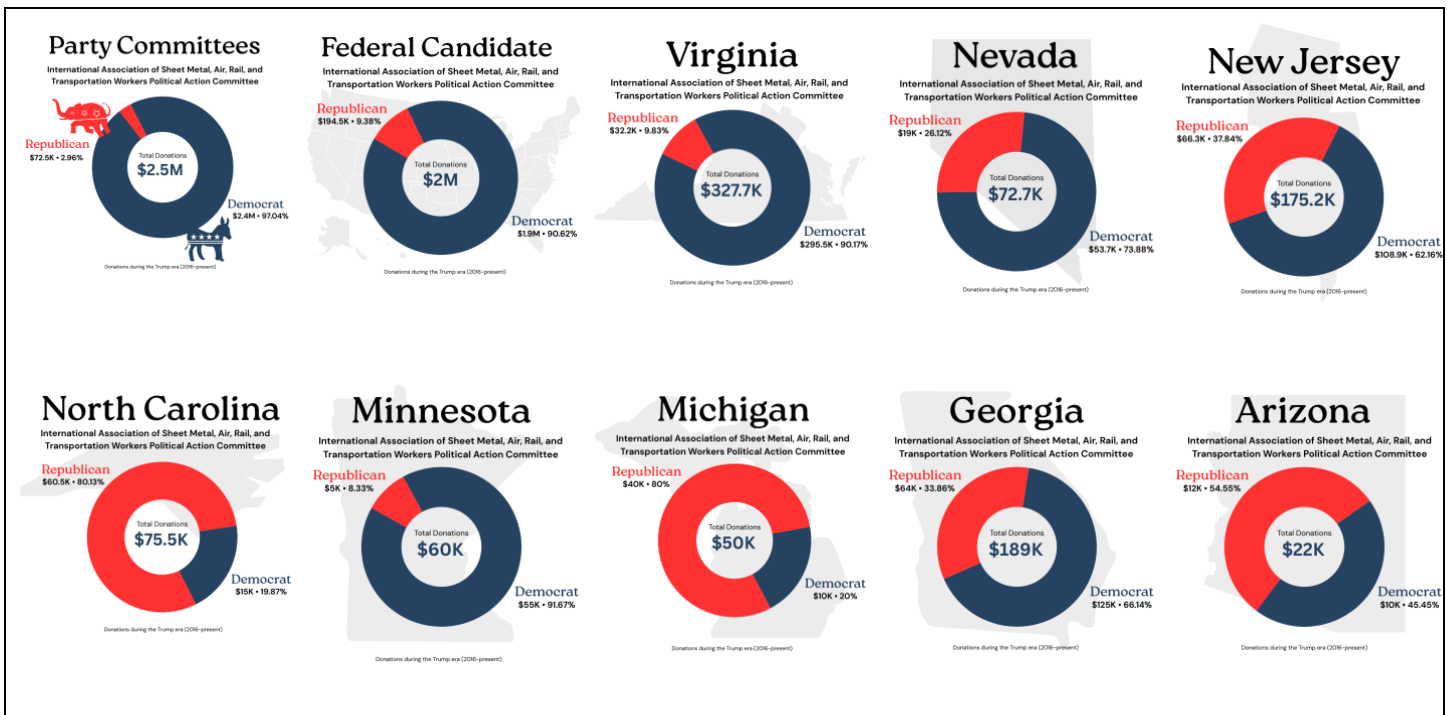

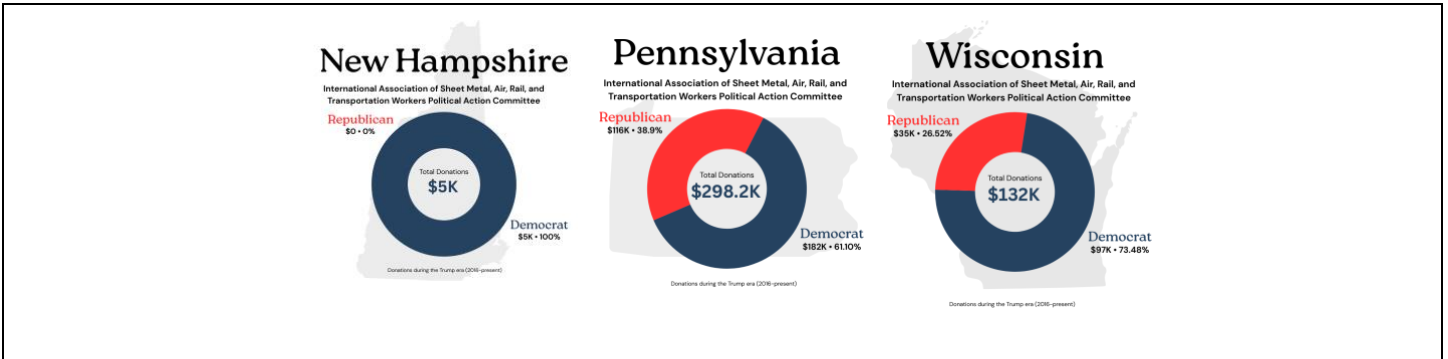

UAW's donations to Democratic party apparatchiks are just a small sample of the union's overwhelmingly biased political view that is seen throughout the unions LM-2 files.

## UAW V-CAP Functions as a Financial Engine for Democratic Power





UAW V-CAP’s spending pattern leaves little room for interpretation. The committee directed \$6,383,914.48 to Democratic party committees compared to \$0.00 to Republican.

The federal candidate numbers are just as lopsided. UAW V-CAP sent \$5,323,500.00 to Democratic federal candidates and just \$45,000.00 to Republicans. That means 99.16% of federal candidate dollars flowed to Democrats and only 0.84% to Republicans. For every dollar directed to a Republican federal candidate, roughly 118.3 dollars went to a Democrat. This is not balanced political participation. It is a sustained financial commitment to one side.

While minor deviations appear in isolated state contexts, notable in Michigan and North Carolina where they had small spends, those exceptions are numerically insignificant when compared to the scale of federal and national spending. The overwhelming share of high-impact dollars flowed to Democratic candidates and Democratic political infrastructure in the contests that shape congressional control.

The PAC’s largest disbursement targets underscore that alignment.

- SENATE MAJORITY PAC received \$5,145,000.00; <sup>3</sup>
- HOUSE MAJORITY PAC received \$6,390,000.00; <sup>4</sup>
- MICHIGAN DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL received \$2,200,000.00; <sup>5</sup>

These are not incidental checks. They are institutional investments reinforcing Democratic electoral strength at the national level.

***Independent Expenditures Just as Biased***

Independent expenditure activity, totaling \$846,660.22, reinforces the same directional pattern. The overwhelming share of reported spending supported Democratic candidates or opposed Republican candidates. Hard dollars and independent expenditures move in the same direction, reflecting a unified political strategy.

**Waste and Abuse Within the Union**

While UAW’s treasury ought to be used for the betterment of its workers, it is instead used for frivolous and wasteful spending, often on entertainment, luxury accommodations, or leftist activism.

**Overall Spending**

The UAW spent over \$300,000,000 on political spending, legal, hotel and conference, travel, swag, food and beverage, and entertainment.<sup>6</sup>

On average, UAW members contribute 2.5 hours a month of their work to the union, in return the UAW leadership doles out large salaries and an extraordinary biased political agenda.<sup>9</sup>

## Anti-MAGA Advocacy by Union Leaders and Organizational Wokeness

UAW leadership has positioned the Union to be in direct opposition to the Trump Administration, consistently decrying them at every step while engaging in self-enrichment using funds for luxury vacations. Further, UAW President Shawn Fain consistently decries capitalism, wants to “eat the rich”, and the Union accuses Israel of genocide.

### Opposition to President Trump

#### *Trump's Chief Antagonist*

The official UAW X account endorsed a Jacobin article which posits themselves as Donald Trumps “Chief Antagonist”.<sup>10</sup> The article speaks of “an all-out war” between Donald Trump and UAW, where UAW seeks to thwart Donald Trump at any turn due to his perceived alignment with “billionaires” such as Elon Musk over the working class.<sup>11</sup>

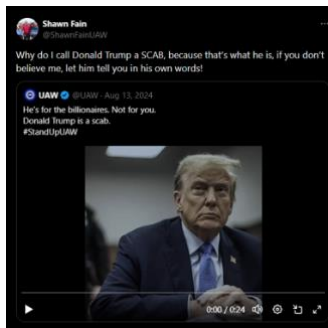

In Aug. 2024, UAW President Shawn Fain bad mouthed the President on his personal X account calling President Trump a “scab.”<sup>12</sup>



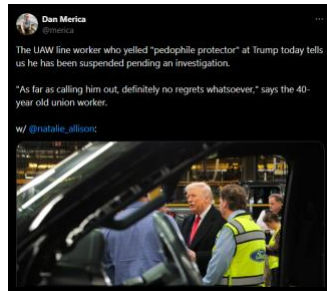
### ***Supported Worker Calling President Trump a “Pedophile Protector”***

### ***Shawn Fain Admires Radical Activist Malcolm X***

Finally, Fain draws inspiration from and quotes Malcolm X, a controversial civil rights figure who was a part of the Nation of Islam (which believes Black people are the “original” people and White people are devils, created by an evil scientist) for most of his life and advocated for racial separation between Whites and Blacks.<sup>19</sup>

### **Democratic Party Endorsements**

UAW goes out of its way to endorse radical Democratic Socialist candidates which stand against everything the Trump administration is trying to do. These candidates oppose commonsense immigration enforcement, want to “transition” minors, and endorse a whole host of other leftist positions. UAW is happy to throw their lot in with them, alongside mainstream Democrats who endorse similar positions.

### ***Endorsing Democratic Socialist Candidates***

UAW has gone out of its way to affiliate with and endorse several current and former members of the Democratic Socialists of America (DSA). To put it into perspective, the DSA advocates the total abolition of ICE, stating in a press release relating to Bovino being reassigning from Minnesota and Tom Homan stepping in:<sup>20</sup>

Make no mistake, the decision by the Trump Administration to remove Bovino is an intentional distraction meant to demobilize this mass movement. Tom Homan, who is set to replace Bovino, has the same cruel intention — kidnapping our neighbors — thus our demands have not changed:

- Abolish ICE
- No More Occupations of American Cities by the Federal Government
- Prosecute All Federal Agents Found Breaking the Law

We will not back down until every single immigrant is safe from ICE.

Further, the DSA endorses putting minors on “gender affirming care”, an approach that typically involves putting a child on “puberty blockers” and later cross sex hormones. This causes immeasurable, physical, mental, and health related complications, including but not limited to permanent infertility, suicidal ideation, loss of sexual function, increased risk for numerous types of cancer, and more. In a statement released April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 regarding a rally to “protect trans kids”, the DSA of NYC say:<sup>21</sup>

Over five hundred protesters braved the rain in Madison Square Park on International Trans Day of Visibility. While the day’s earlier protest promised to defend trans rights broadly, **the focus of the evening rally was pressuring New York hospitals to provide gender-affirming care for trans patients 18 and under.** The rally, organized by the New York City chapter of the Democratic Socialists of America (NYC-DSA) in coalition with Jews for Racial & Economic Justice (JFREJ), Black Trans Liberation Kitchen, and NYC Youth 4 Trans Rights, concluded with NY State Senator Kristen Gonzalez leading the crowd to NYU Langone’s Tisch Hospital to deliver a portion of the over 225,000 signed letters demanding that the hospital resume care.

This just highlights two egregious examples by the DSA. The DSA is as left as it comes, riddled with leftist social justice and economic positions. UAW has firmly aligned themselves with the DSA against the interests of the American people, and against Donald Trump and the Republican Party.

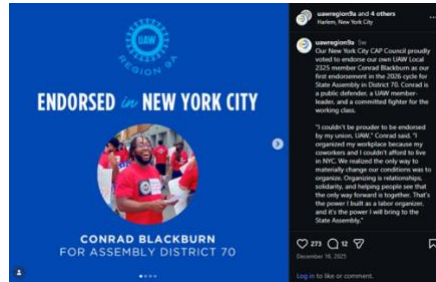
